WINEMAKING

Our estate block of Gewurztraminer was separated into two micro-blocks as over the course of many years we have found that the two sections progress through the growing season with slightly different rhythms. The first pick came in on September 17th and the second pick came in on September 23rd. Both lots were destemmed and left on skins for a few hours of cold soaking before being pressed to stainless steel tank for long, cool fermentations. After the fermentations were complete, the cellar team tasted through several blends before assembling the final 2019 Gewurztraminer.

TASTING NOTES

The 2019 Gewurztraminer is 100% estate grown. Bright lemon, orange and pineapple lead to the broad mid-palate, as the spicy muscat character emerges and carries through into the fresh, well-balanced finish.

PAIRING

The balanced residual sugar in the wine allows it to pair well with spicy fish tacos and curries, but it would also work well with barbecued chicken or cheese plates.
